I can get inside two ways.




I can walk up the stairs.




Or I can go through the stroller and wheelchair entrance.


When I walk inside, I will see lots of fun things.

I will stay close to my adult and use walking feet.




I will see museum workers. They wear blue aprons. They can help me.

I can go upstairs and downstairs two different ways.




I can walk up the stairs with my adult.



Or I can ride in the elevator with my adult.


If I need a break, I will tell my adult.

If I need to go to the restroom, I will tell my adult.




They will help me find a restroom.

This is Toothasaurus. I can be a dentist.






This is Animal Alley. I can learn how to take care of pets.

This is Construction Junction. I can learn about building and construction.




Safety first!

This is Skeleworld. I can learn about my body.








This is Wellness Way. I can learn how to take care of babies.

I can go grocery shopping.






This is Kid Power. I can do different exercises.
